



# Cookie Policy

A cookie is a small piece of data stored by a website within a browser on the website visitor's device. We use cookies to help us to improve our site and to provide us with information about usage of the website. Certain third parties also place cookies on your device when you browse our website.

The web browsers you are currently using will allow you to have some control over the saving of cookies on your computer, tablet or smartphone through your browser settings. Our website may save cookies on your device as soon as you visit any page unless you have set your browser to refuse cookies. We use a number of suppliers who may also set cookies on or for their websites. We do not control the dissemination of these cookies found in other companies' internet tools which we use to enhance our site; for example, Twitter have their own cookies, which are controlled by them.
